

It offers a simple, hands on way for families to build financial confidence early. TruNorth members can open a Greenlight account at no cost, a \$69 value, making it an easy win for parents.

Parents can instantly send money, set spending limits, and control where their child can spend, with real-time notifications for every purchase. As kids grow, Greenlight also supports allowances, chores, savings, and investing, turning everyday spending into a secure, educational experience.

TAX DOCUMENTS


Available under eStatements in online banking

BE AWARE OF SCAMS


CRYPTO

Cryptocurrency-related scams are increasing, and we encourage members to stay alert. Common red flags include promises of “guaranteed” returns, pressure to invest quickly, unsolicited messages from supposed advisors, and requests for payment in cryptocurrency. Never share your online banking information, grant remote access to your device, or send money to unfamiliar investment platforms or “crypto recovery” services. Once funds are transferred, they are often impossible to recover.



If you receive a suspicious request or believe you may have been targeted, contact 906-485-1210 immediately. We're here to help protect your accounts and keep you safe.

IMPERSONATION SCAMS



Impersonation scams are on the rise, with fraudsters posing as credit union staff, government agencies, delivery services, or tech support to gain access to your personal or financial information. They may contact you by phone, text, or email and use urgent language to pressure you into acting quickly. Remember: TruNorth FCU will never ask for your online banking password, verification codes, or remote access to your devices. Do not click suspicious links, provide personal information, or send money to anyone you cannot verify.

If you receive a questionable message or call, hang up and contact 906-485-1210 directly. Staying cautious is the best way to protect your accounts.



“TRUNORTH FRAUD DEPARTMENT”

Scammers are increasingly impersonating TruNorth FCU by phone, text, or email in an effort to steal personal or financial information. They may spoof our phone number, use our logo, or claim there is an urgent issue with your account to pressure you into acting quickly. Please remember that we will never ask for your online banking password, verification codes, PIN, or remote access to your device.

If you receive a message or call that doesn't seem right, do not respond, click links, or provide any information.



Always contact 906-485-1210 directly using our official number to confirm whether a request is legitimate. Your caution is key to keeping your accounts safe.
