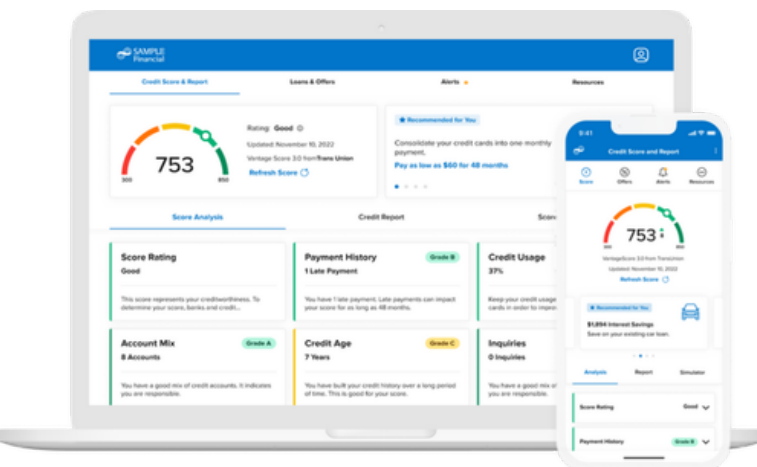

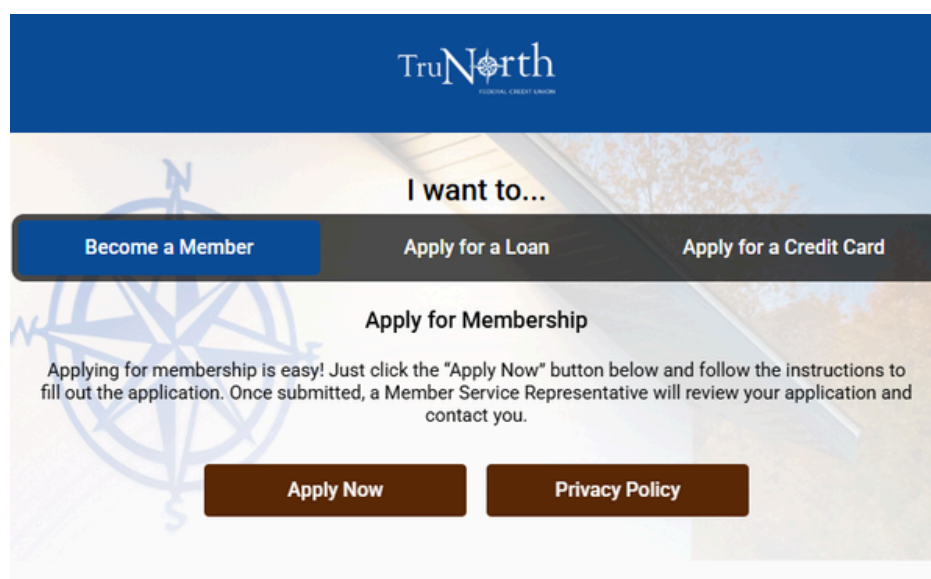

Bring a chair. Free to the public!



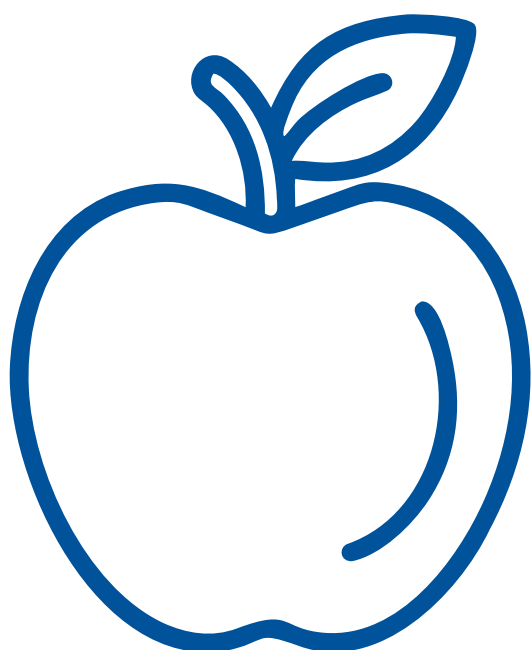
TEACHER GIVEAWAY

BE AWARE OF SCAMS

At TruNorth, your financial security is our top priority. We want to make you aware of a growing number of online loan scams targeting consumers with promises of fast, easy approval. These fraudulent lenders often request your bank account information early in the process, sometimes even asking for fees before the loan is approved. Once they gain access to your account, they may withdraw funds or use your information for further fraudulent activity.

Please remember: a legitimate lender will never ask for full access to your account or require upfront payments before issuing a loan. If you are considering borrowing, we encourage you to work directly with trusted, local institutions like your credit union, where your safety comes first.

If you ever feel unsure about a loan offer or have concerns about your account, do not hesitate to contact us. We are here to help you make safe, informed financial decisions every step of the way.



SCAM MESSAGES: GIFT CARDS

Scammers often pose as trusted organizations, government agencies, or even family members in urgent situations. They may claim you owe money, have won a prize, or need to help someone quickly. They will then instruct you to buy gift cards and provide the card numbers and PINs. Once those codes are shared, the money is gone and nearly impossible to recover. Please remember that legitimate businesses and agencies will never ask for payment using gift cards. If someone pressures you to act quickly or insists on this type of payment, it is a strong warning sign of a scam.

If you receive a suspicious request or are unsure about a situation, contact us right away. We are here to help you protect your money and make confident, informed decisions.
